Your Responsibilities will include:

- Collaborating with the campaign manager on creative design and build practices, ensuring accurate costings.
- Attending client meeting and site visits required.
- Overseeing budget for each assets production, in line with approved designs.
- Coordinating suppliers for each asset across multiple campaigns.
- Communicating timelines to campaign managers and ensuring deadlines are met.
- Managing the end-to-end process, from design and creation to onsite delivery.
- Closely tracking and managing assigned budgets and expenses.
- Understanding asset design requirements for different environments.
- Supporting onsite builds to meet specified requirements.
- Creating detailed build plans and health and safety documentation.
- Managing onsite crews, suppliers, and sub-contractors.
- Supporting the Senior Production Manager with tasks and campaigns.

You will need:

- A minimum of 3 years' experience in event production and build.
- A solid understanding of all technical aspects of live event production, including sound, lighting, rigging, and brand activations.
